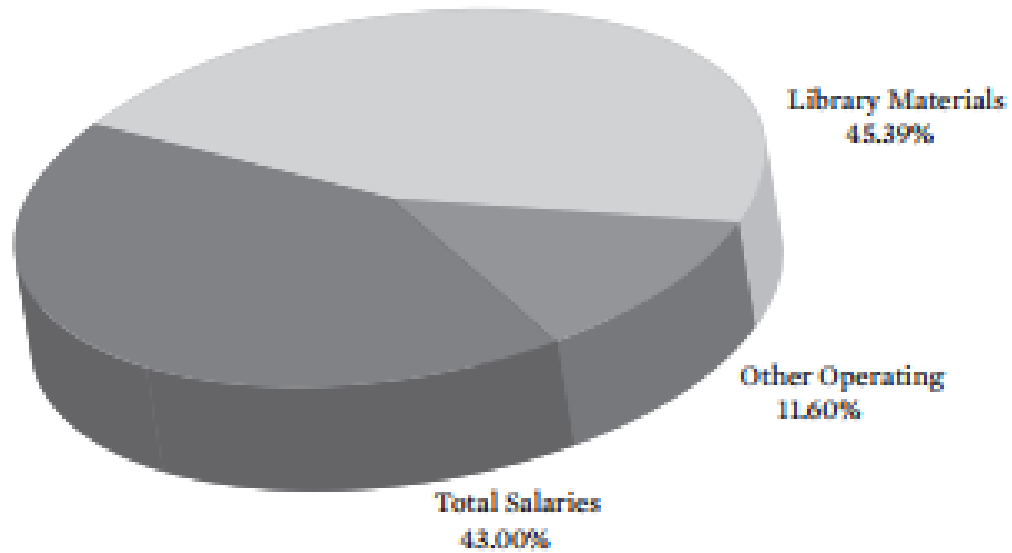

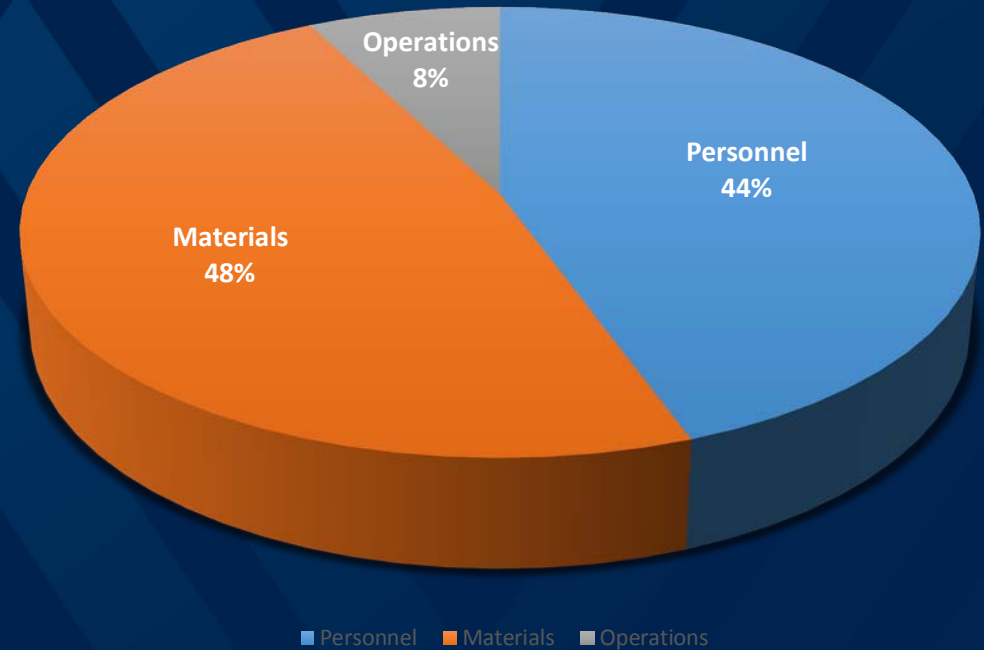

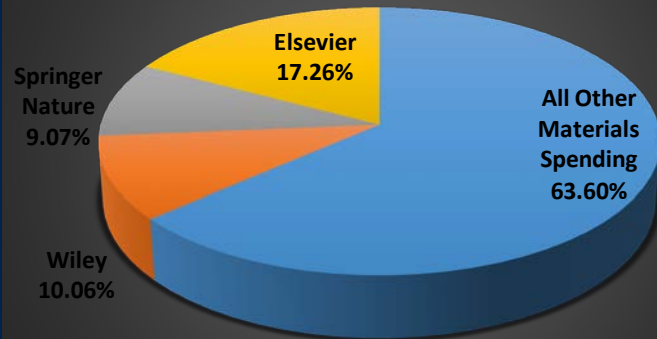
# Rising costs of library resources

  - Elsevier

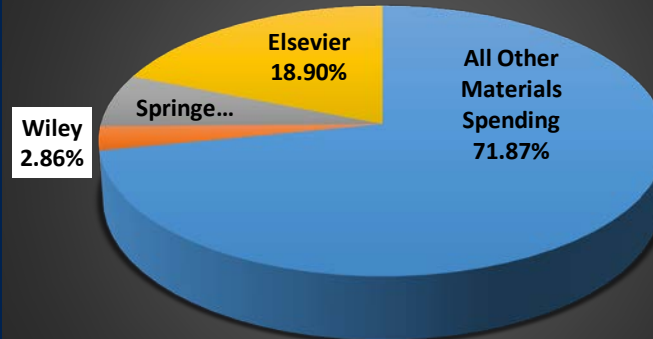


# Rising costs of library resources

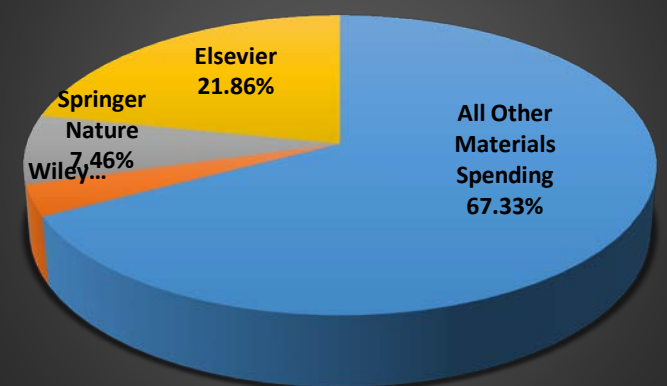
FY16 Main Library Spending



FY17 Main Library Spending

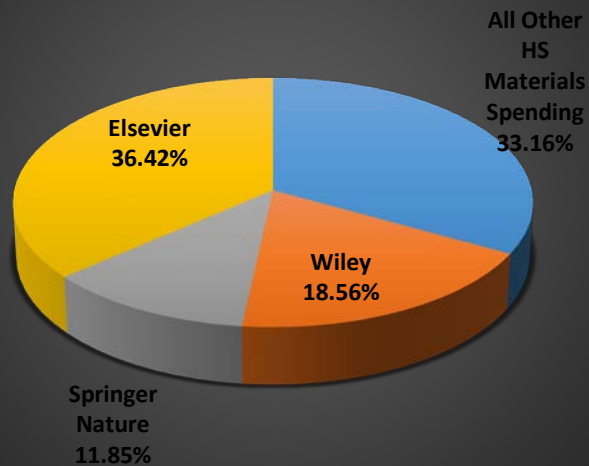


FY18 Main Library Spending Without Reduction

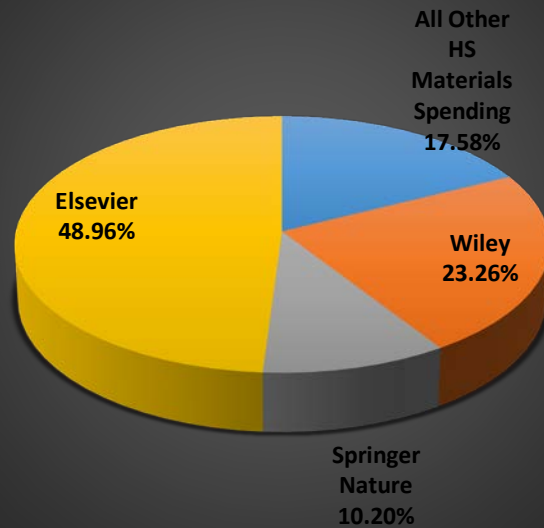

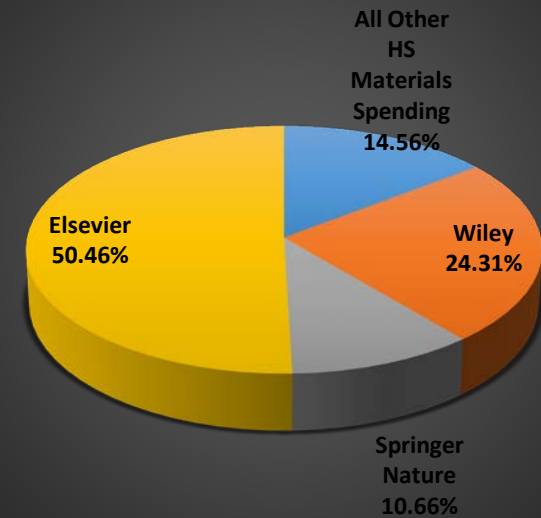
**FY16 Health Sciences Spending**
