QR or "Quick Response" codes are 2 Dimensional barcodes. They are a way of bridging the gap between physical objects and digital content.

A QR code can be printed and affixed to a physical object or place (e.g. photocopier, poster, study room door, web page, anything) and, once decoded by a smartphone application, it will take you online to a website or display a picture, send a text message, etc. QR codes can also be placed in books and magazines, or on business cards, or other deliverables.
